A Place to Call Home will support **5,500 older people** in deprived communities to help them live in safe, secure and warm homes.

Skilled advisors will help older people, in their own homes and over the phone, by:

- Enabling them to **increase their income** by accessing the benefits they are entitled to, such as Pension Credit, so they can cover essential household expenses, from heating to food and care needs to home repairs.
- **Keeping their homes warm** through energy efficiency measures and benefits like the Warm Home Discount.
- Helping them to get the social care they need to **live independently** - from aids and adaptations, like handrails and stairlifts, to support with preparing meals and help to wash and dress.
- Connecting those experiencing social isolation at home with **friendship**.

We'll also undertake vital research on the impact of the cost-of-living crisis to influence the government to do the right thing for older people.
